E-MAIL PRIVACY

Your e-mail address will only be used within Indian River Community Foundation. Indian River Community Foundation does not share, sell or rent e-mail addresses to anyone outside the organization. If you do not wish to receive e-mail correspondence, please e-mail your request to donorservices@ircommunityfoundation.org or call the Indian River Community Foundation at (772) 492-1407.

USE OF IP ADDRESSES AND COOKIES

A unique number called an IP address identifies every computer on the Internet. Each time you connect to the Internet your machine is assigned an IP address. An IP address is a number that identifies each sender or receiver of information that is sent in packets across the Internet. Indian River Community Foundation uses your IP address to help diagnose problems with our server, and to administer Indian River Community Foundation website.

"Cookies" are small pieces of information that are stored by your browser on your computer's hard drive. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but if you prefer, you can edit your browser options to block them in the future. Indian River Community Foundation uses cookies to

maintain user session identity, and, in some non-member areas, to store your username and password locally for ease of access.

Indian River Community Foundation may also collect certain demographic information about visitors to www.ircommunityfoundation.org through the use of cookies. Indian River Community Foundation only uses this data to improve the overall www.ircommunityfoundation.org website and for internal business purposes.

SITE/MEMBERSHIP REGISTRATION FORMS

Indian River Community Foundation's website registration forms require users to give us contact information (such as name and e-mail address), method of payment, and demographic information. Indian River Community Foundation may use customer contact information from the registration forms to send the user information about Indian River Community Foundation. The customer's contact information is also used to contact the visitor when necessary. Information regarding method of payment is collected for member enrollment, registration and to process orders for products and services.
